- *Note that this is a general list, common to all grade one FI classes.
 - ◆ Teachers will be reaching out in September with supplies necessary for their specific classes.
- If this list poses a financial hardship for you, please do not hesitate to contact the school. We are happy to help you.
- Please drop off all supplies on Sept. 4 - curriculum night!

Please:

- **Label all of your child's supplies with permanent marker** except:
 - ◆ Do NOT label: pencils, glue sticks, white glue, and Sharpies
- **REMOVE ALL packaging from supplies**
- Place supplies in an extra-large Ziploc bag (available at Dollar Store).
 - ◆ Your child's extra supplies will be stored in the extra-large ziplock bag during the year.
- You will also need a reusable grocery bag (see below for details).

In the extra-large Ziploc bag: (labeled clearly with your child's name)

- 12 HB pencils- **sharpened** please
 - HB as others do not stay sharpened. (Do not label with your child's name, please)
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 large white eraser (not the pink kind)
- 2 pairs of scissors
- 1 large glue stick (do not label with your child's name, please)
- 1 bottle of white glue (do not label with your child's name, please)
- 1 pack of coloured pencils (24 pack)
- 2 packages of **large** markers for colouring (unscented, washable, not thin - they dry out).
- 1 thin highlighter (used for printing practice). Please do not send fat ones, as they are hard to grip properly.

In a separate bag, such as a reusable grocery bag, please put:

- 1 canvas zippered messenger/courier bag
 - **This item is an absolute must.** These are available at the Dollar Store.
- 1 plastic pencil box - ensure it will fit 4 pencils, an eraser, scissors, pencil sharpener
- 4 regular-sized Hilroy exercise notebooks
 - Generally 80 pages, 27.6cm x 21.2cm
- 2 small yellow Hilroy exercise books (half lined, half plain)
 - Generally 72 pages 23.1cm x 18.0cm
 - These are NOT the same as the regular sized, above. If you need help differentiating between the two, please email Mme. Beth at bcarroll@gnspes.ca
- 2 small exercise books, blank inside
 - If you cannot find these, send more of the half lined exercise books. We have a new paper quota, and so will be using notebooks more than before.
- 4 duotangs
- 1 pocket folder
 - Ensure that it does indeed have pockets on the insides - these are used for writing folders and are not the same as duotangs. Try to avoid the ones that have prongs for duotangs, as they don't fit paper as well inside.
- 1 normal-sized art sketch pad (NOT large please! Approx. 8 ½ x 11 inch sized)
 - Available at the dollar store - this will be used informally during quiet time, so does not need to be high quality.
- 1 set of headphones
 - Preferably ones that cover the ears, rather than earbuds, which can be difficult for young learners. These will be used with Chomebooks, but not until the new year (likely Feb), so no worries if you can't get them right away.
- 1 pair of indoor shoes
 - To keep at school - **clearly labeled with permanent marker.**
- **Extra clothes in a Ziploc:**
 - 1 pair of underwear, socks, an extra shirt, and extra pants (such as tights or jogging pants) to keep at school in case of accidents, **all clearly labeled on the bag and also on the clothing tags.**
